1-16 Amend H.B. No. 776 (house engrossed version) in SECTION 1 of
1-17 the bill, in amended Section 572.032(a-1), Government Code (page 1,
1-18 line 7), between "address" and "of", by inserting "the telephone
1-19 number, and the names of the dependent children".

1-20 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to the removal of home addresses from personal financial
1-23 statements filed by certain persons.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 572.032(a-1), Government Code, is
1-26 amended to read as follows:

1-27 (a-1) The commission shall remove the home address of an
1-28 individual [a judge or justice] from a financial statement filed by
1-29 the individual under this subchapter before:

1-30 (1) permitting a member of the public to view the
1-31 statement; ~~or~~

1-32 (2) providing a copy of the statement to a member of
1-33 the public; or

1-34 (3) making the statement available to the public on
1-35 the commission's Internet website, if the commission makes
1-36 statements filed under this subchapter available on its website.

1-37 SECTION 2. Section 572.032(a-1), Government Code, as
1-38 amended by this Act, applies to a financial statement filed under
1-39 Subchapter B, Chapter 572, Government Code, regardless of whether
1-40 the statement was required to be filed before, on, or after the
1-41 effective date of this Act.

1-42 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-43 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-44 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-45 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-46 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
