## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the frequency of criminal background checks for sports
- 3 officials registered with the University Interscholastic League;
- 4 authorizing a fee.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 33.085, Education Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsections (b), (c), and (e), and adding Subsection (c-1)
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 (b) The league may require a sports official, as a condition
- 10 of eligibility to officiate a contest sponsored by the league, to:
- 11 (1) be registered with the league and comply with the
- 12 registration requirements of <u>Subsections</u> [<del>Subsection</del>] (c) <u>and</u>
- 13 (c-1);
- 14 (2) have completed initial and continuing education
- 15 programs regarding league rules;
- 16 (3) be a member in good standing of a local chapter or
- 17 association of sports officials recognized by the league for that
- 18 purpose; and
- 19 (4) agree to abide by league rules, including fee
- 20 schedules and travel reimbursement guidelines for payment by school
- 21 districts or open-enrollment charter schools to a sports official.
- (c) In registering with the league, a sports official must
- 23 be required to provide directory information required by the league
- 24 and submit to an initial [a] criminal background check.

- 1 (c-1) To maintain registration with the league, a sports
- 2 official must be required to submit to a subsequent criminal
- 3 background check once every three years following the initial
- 4 criminal background check under Subsection (c).
- 5 (e) The league may charge and collect a registration fee
- 6 only to defray the cost of registering sports officials  $\underline{\text{under}}$
- 7 Subsection (c). The league may charge and collect a criminal
- 8 background check fee only to defray the cost of administering
- 9 Subsection (c-1). The league [and] shall post the amount of the
- 10 <u>applicable fees</u> [the fee] on the league's Internet website and make
- 11 the information available at other places the league determines
- 12 appropriate. The amount of each [the] fee may not exceed the
- 13 amount reasonably determined by the league to be necessary to cover
- 14 the cost, as applicable, of administering registration under
- 15 <u>Subsection (c) or administering Subsection (c-1)</u>.
- SECTION 2. (a) Section 33.085, Education Code, as amended
- 17 by this Act, applies to each sports official authorized to
- 18 officiate a contest sponsored by the University Interscholastic
- 19 League, regardless of whether an official initially registered with
- 20 the league under that section before the effective date of this Act.
- 21 (b) The University Interscholastic League shall ensure that
- 22 each sports official registered under Section 33.085, Education
- 23 Code, before the effective date of this Act submits to a subsequent
- 24 criminal background check not later than September 1, 2020.
- 25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
