A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-17 1-18 relating to eligibility for the Texas Armed Services Scholarship Program. 1-19

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 61.9772(a), Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 1-21

1-22 1-23 То initial scholarship (a) receive an under this subchapter, a student must:

1-24 (1) be enrolled in a public or private institution of 1-25 higher education in this state;

2-4 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply
