A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to liability of certain electric utilities that allow certain uses of land that the electric utility owns, occupies, or 3 4 leases. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Section 75.0022(b), Civil Practice and Remedies 6 Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 This section applies only to an electric utility located 8 9 in: (1) a county with a population of four million or more; 10 11 or

- 12 (2) a county with a population of 550,000 or more that
- is adjacent to a county described by Subdivision (1).
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
- 16 this Act. A cause of action that accrues before the effective date
- 17 of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before that
- 18 date, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
