## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the authority of the asset management division of the 3 General Land Office to sell real property to a federally recognized 4 Indian tribe.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 31.0672(a), Natural Resources Code, is 7 amended to read as follows:

(a) The division may directly sell to a political 8 9 subdivision, [or] a development corporation organized under Subtitle C1, Title 12, Local Government Code, or a federally 10 recognized Indian tribe, as listed by the United States secretary 11 12 of the interior under 25 U.S.C. Section 5131, any real property owned by the state that the legislature has authorized or the 13 14 governor has approved for sale under Subchapter E if the commissioner determines the sale is in the best interest of the 15 16 state.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
