- 6 SECTION 1. Section 31.0672(a), Natural Resources Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The division may directly sell to a political
- 9 subdivision, [or] a development corporation organized under
- 10 Subtitle C1, Title 12, Local Government Code, or a federally
- 11 recognized Indian tribe, as listed by the United States secretary
- 12 of the interior under 25 U.S.C. Section 5131, any real property
- 13 owned by the state that the legislature has authorized or the
- 14 governor has approved for sale under Subchapter E if the
- 15 commissioner determines the sale is in the best interest of the
- 16 state.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
