A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to mediation of the settlement of certain out-of-network 1-19 1-20 health benefit claims involving balance billing for members of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas. 1-21

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Sections 1467.001(1) and (3), Insurance Code, are amended to read as follows: 1-24 1-25 (1)

"Administrator" means:

(A) an administering firm for a health benefit plan providing coverage under Chapter 1551, 1575, or 1579; and (B) if applicable, the claims administrator for 1-26 1-27 1-28

1-29 the health benefit plan. "Enrollee" means an individual who is eligible to 1-30 (3) receive benefits through a preferred provider benefit plan or a 1-31 1-32

health benefit plan under Chapter 1551, 1575, or 1579. SECTION 2. Section 1467.002, Insurance Code, 1-33 is amended to 1-34 read as follows:

Sec. 1467.002. APPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER. 1-35 This chapter 1-36 applies to:

1-37 (1) a preferred provider benefit plan offered by an 1-38 insurer under Chapter 1301; and

1-39 (2) an administrator of a health benefit plan, other 1-40 than a health maintenance organization plan, under Chapter 1551, 1-41 <u>1575, or 1579</u>.

SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 1-42 a health benefit claim for a medical service or supply provided on 1-43 1 - 44or after January 1, 2018. A claim for a medical service or supply provided before January 1, 2018, is governed by the law as it 1-45 existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that 1-46 1-47 law is continued in effect for that purpose. 1-48

SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
