1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to the statute of limitations applicable to the collection
1-23 of a contribution, a penalty, or interest under the Texas
1-24 Unemployment Compensation Act.

1-25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-26 SECTION 1. Sections 213.033(b) and (c), Labor Code, are
1-27 amended to read as follows:

1-28 (b) The following actions suspend the running of the
1-29 limitations period prescribed under Subsection (a):

1-30 (1) an administrative hearing to redetermine the
1-31 liability for a contribution, a penalty, or interest pending before
1-32 the commission; and

1-33 (2) a judicial proceeding to redetermine the liability
1-34 for a contribution, a penalty, or interest pending in a court of
1-35 competent jurisdiction; and

1-36 (3) [+2] a bankruptcy case begun under Title 11 of
1-37 the United States Code pending before the court.

1-38 (c) After a hearing, proceeding, or case described by
1-39 Subsection (b) is closed, the running of the limitations period
1-40 prescribed under Subsection (a) resumes.

1-41 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-42 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-43 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-44 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-45 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
