A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to requiring certain school districts to adopt a policy
- 3 allowing students who participate in Special Olympics to earn a
- 4 letter on that basis.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 33.093 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 33.093. RECOGNITION OF PARTICIPATION IN SPECIAL
- 9 OLYMPICS. If a school district allows high school students to earn
- 10 a letter for academic, athletic, or extracurricular achievements,
- 11 the district shall adopt a policy that allows high school students
- 12 in the district to earn a letter on the basis of a student's
- 13 participation in a Special Olympics event.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
- 15 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
