## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-21 relating to requiring certain school districts to allow students
1-22 who participate in Special Olympics to earn a letter on that basis.
1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 33, Education Code, is 1-25 amended by adding Section 33.093 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 33.093. RECOGNITION OF PARTICIPATION IN SPECIAL 1-27 OLYMPICS. If a school district allows high school students to earn 1-28 a letter for academic, athletic, or extracurricular achievements, 1-29 the district must allow high school students in the district to earn 1-30 a letter on the basis of a student's participation in a Special 1-31 Olympics event. 1-32 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018

1-32 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018 1-33 school year.

1-34 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-35 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-36 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-37 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-38 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
