SECTION 1. Section 71.155, Business & Commerce Code, is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to is 1-21 1-22 1-23 read as follows:

1-24 Except as provided by Subsection (a-1), the [The] county (a) 1-25 clerk shall collect a fee of:

(1) \$2 for filing each certificate or 1-26 statement 1-27 1-28 required or permitted to be filed under this chapter; and (2) 50 cents for each name to be indexed.

1-29 (a-1) The county clerk may waive all fees under Subsection (a) for a registrant who is a military veteran. In this subsection, "military veteran" has the meaning assigned by Section 55.001, 1-30 1-31 Occupations Code. SECTION 2. 1-32 1-33
