## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to the required qualifications for serving as president of the University of North Texas Health Science Center at Fort Worth 1-17 1-18 1-19 and to the prohibition against the award of certain degrees by the center's governing board. 1-20 1-21

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 105.102(b), Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-24 (b) The board shall appoint a president of each component institution who serves as chief executive officer of the institution. [The president of the University of North Texas Health Science Center at Fort Worth must be a licensed physician who possesses a doctor of osteopathy degree from an accredited college 1-25 1-26 1-27 1-28 of osteopathic medicine and must have been licensed to practice 1-29 medicine in a state of the United States for at least five years.] 1-30

SECTION 2. Section 105.402, Education Code, is repealed. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-31 1-32 1-33 1-34 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-35 1-36 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
