## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-21 relating to contract requirements for prescription drug benefits
1-22 provided by Medicaid managed care organizations.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 533.005(a-1), Government Code, is 1-25 amended to read as follows:

1-26 (a-1) The requirements imposed by Subsections (a)(23)(A), 1-27 (B), and (C) do not apply, and may not be enforced, on and after 1-28 August 31, 2023 [2018]. 1-29 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act

1-29 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act 1-30 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a 1-31 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, 1-32 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or 1-33 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the 1-34 waiver or authorization is granted.

1-35 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-36 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-37 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-38 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-39 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
