A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-17 relating to the location of the Irma Rangel College of Pharmacy. 1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-19 SECTION 1. Section 89.051(b), Education Code, is amended to 1-20 read as follows:

1-21 (b) The college shall be known as The Texas A&M University 1-22 System Health Science Center Irma Lerma Rangel College of Pharmacy, 1-23 and the primary building in which the school is operated <u>shall be</u> 1-24 <u>located</u> in Kleberg County <u>and</u> must include "Irma Rangel" in its 1-25 official name.

1-26 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-28 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-29 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-30 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
