1-20 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-21 AN ACT

1-22 relating to providing workplace safety training information for use
 1-23 in the public school curriculum.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
 1-26 amended by adding Section 29.923 to read as follows:

1-27 Sec. 29.923. WORKPLACE SAFETY TRAINING INFORMATION. (a)
 1-28 The agency shall collect and make available to a school district on
 1-29 request information regarding workplace safety training that may be
 1-30 included as part of the district's curriculum.

1-31 (b) A school district may develop a workplace safety program
 1-32 that provides educators access to the information described by
 1-33 Subsection (a) and encourages educators to include the workplace
 1-34 safety training information in the curriculum of appropriate
 1-35 courses provided to students enrolled in grades 7 through 12.

1-36 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
 1-37 school year.

1-38 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-39 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-40 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-41 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-42 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
