## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to a report of child abuse or neglect made by an employee

- 3 of a school district or an open-enrollment charter school.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 38.004(a), Education Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) The agency shall develop a policy governing the reports
- 8 of child abuse or neglect, including reports related to the
- 9 trafficking of a child under Section 20A.02(a)(5), (6), (7), or
- 10 (8), Penal Code, as required by Chapter 261, Family Code, for school
- 11 districts, open-enrollment charter schools, and their employees.
- 12 The policy must provide for cooperation with law enforcement child
- 13 abuse investigations without the consent of the child's parents if
- 14 necessary, including investigations by the Department of Family and
- 15 Protective Services. The policy must require each school district
- 16 and open-enrollment charter school employee to report child abuse
- 17 or neglect, including the trafficking of a child under Section
- 18 20A.02(a)(5) or (7), Penal Code, in the manner required by Chapter
- 19 261, Family Code, except that a school district or open-enrollment
- 20 charter school employee must make the report to both the Department
- 21 of Family and Protective Services and a local or state law
- 22 enforcement agency. Each school district and open-enrollment
- 23 charter school shall adopt the policy.
- SECTION 2. Section 261.103, Family Code, is amended by

- 1 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
- 2 follows:
- 3 (a) Except as <u>otherwise</u> provided by <u>this section</u>
- 4 [Subsections (b) and (c)] and Section 261.405, a report shall be
- 5 made to:
- 6 (1) any local or state law enforcement agency;
- 7 (2) the department; or
- 8 (3) the state agency that operates, licenses,
- 9 certifies, or registers the facility in which the alleged abuse or
- 10 neglect occurred.
- 11 (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, an
- 12 <u>employee of a school district or open-enrollment charter school who</u>
- 13 is required to make a report of child abuse or neglect, including
- 14 the trafficking of a child under Section 20A.02(a)(5) or (7), Penal
- 15 Code, must make a report to both the department and to a local or
- 16 <u>state law enforcement agency.</u>
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
