1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to certain identifying information regarding career
1-22 school or college students.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 132.024(a)(2), Education Code, is
1-25 amended to read as follows:

1-26 (2) "Student information" means identifying
1-27 information [~~in the commission's possession~~] regarding a student
1-28 that is in the possession of the commission, a career school or
1-29 college, or any other school, educational institution, or business
1-30 entity from which the commission receives, or regarding which the
1-31 commission reviews, information through its administration or
1-32 enforcement of this chapter. The term includes:

1-33 (A) a student's name, address, telephone number,
1-34 social security number, e-mail address, or date of birth;

1-35 (B) any other identifying number or other
1-36 information that foreseeably could be combined with other publicly
1-37 available information to reveal identifying information regarding
1-38 the student; and

1-39 (C) a student's education records, as defined by
1-40 34 C.F.R. Section 99.3.

1-41 SECTION 2. Section 132.024(c), Education Code, is amended
1-42 to read as follows:

1-43 (c) Unless permitted by Subchapter F, Chapter 301, Labor
1-44 Code, 34 C.F.R. Part 99, Subpart D, or commission rule, a person
1-45 commits an offense if the person solicits, discloses, receives, or
1-46 uses, or authorizes, permits, participates in, or acquiesces in
1-47 another person's use of, student information.

1-48 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
