A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-20 relating to prohibiting political contributions and political 1-21 expenditures made by certain persons with public funds; creating a 1-22 criminal offense. 1-23

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 253, Election Code, is amended by adding Section 253.007 to read as follows: 1-24

1-25 Sec. 253.007. UNLAWFUL USE OF PUBLIC FUNDS FOR CONTRIBUTIONS OR EXPENDITURES. (a) An officer or employee of a political subdivision may not spend or authorize the spending of 1-26 1-27 1-28 public funds to make a political contribution or a political 1-29 1-30 expenditure.

(b) An officer or employee of a political subdivision may not directly or indirectly employ a person to use public funds to make an unlawful political contribution or political expenditure. 1-31 1-32 1-33
