Sections 41.001(a) and (c), Election Code, are 4 5 amended to read as follows: (a) Except as otherwise provided by this subchapter, each 6 7 general or special election in this state shall be held on one of the following dates: 8 9 (1) the first Saturday in May in an odd-numbered year; 10 or 11 (2) [the first Saturday in May in an even-numbered 12 year, for an election held by a political subdivision other than a county; or 13 [(3)] the first Tuesday after the first Monday in 14 15 November. (c) Except for an election under Subsection (a) or Section 16 41.0011 [or a runoff election following an election held under 17 Subsection (a)(2)], an election may not be held within 30 days 18 before or after the date of the general election for state and 19 county officers, general primary election, or runoff primary 20 21 election. 22 SECTION 2. Section 41.0052(a), Election Code, is amended to 23 read as follows: (a) The governing body of a political subdivision, other 24

1 than a county or municipal utility district, that holds its general 2 election for officers on a date other than the November uniform 3 election date may, not later than <u>January 1, 2018</u> [December 31, 4 2016], change the date on which it holds its general election for 5 officers to the November uniform election date.

SECTION 3. Section 41.001(d), Election Code, is repealed.
SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
