A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-19 relating to the issuance and enforcement of a subpoena during the 1-20 course of an investigation of a residential mortgage loan servicer. 1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 158, Finance Code, is 1-23 amended by adding Section 158.1045 to read as follows:

1-24 <u>Sec. 158.1045.</u> ISSUANCE AND ENFORCEMENT OF SUBPOENA. (a) 1-25 <u>During an investigation, the commissioner may issue a subpoena that</u> 1-26 <u>is addressed to a peace officer of this state or other person</u> 1-27 <u>authorized by law to serve citation or perfect service. The</u> 1-28 <u>subpoena may require a person to give a deposition, produce</u> 1-29 <u>documents, or both.</u>

1-30 (b) If a person disobeys a subpoena or if a person appearing 1-31 in a deposition in connection with the investigation refuses to 1-32 testify, the commissioner may petition a district court in Travis 1-33 County to issue an order requiring the person to obey the subpoena, 1-34 testify, or produce documents relating to the matter. The court 1-35 shall promptly set an application to enforce a subpoena issued 1-36 under Subsection (a) for hearing and shall cause notice of the 1-37 application and the hearing to be served on the person to whom the 1-38 subpoena is directed.

1-39 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-40 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-41 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-42 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-43 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
