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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-19 relating to the maximum amount of a documentary fee charged by a retail seller of motor vehicles. 1-20 1-21

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Sections 348.006(e) and (f), Finance Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-24 (e) Prior to increasing the maximum amount of the documentary fee the retail seller charges, a retail seller shall 1-25 1-26 provide written notice to the commissioner of the maximum amount of 1-27 1-28 the documentary fee the retail seller intends to charge <u>unless the</u> maximum amount intended to be charged is considered reasonable as provided by Subsection (f). The commissioner may review the amount of a documentary fee a retail seller intends to charge for reasonableness if the retail seller is required to provide written 1-29 1-30 1-31 notice of the fee increase under this subsection. In determining whether a fee charged by a retail seller is reasonable, the commissioner may consider the resources required by the retail 1-32 1-33 1-34 seller to perform the retail seller's duties under state and federal law with respect to the handling and processing of documents relating to the sale and financing of a motor vehicle. If 1-35 1-36 1-37 the commissioner determines that a documentary fee charged is not 1-38 1-39 reasonable, the commissioner may require that the documentary fee charged be reduced or suspended. 1-40

(f) A documentary fee charged in accordance with this section [before September 1, 2009,] is considered reasonable for 1-41 1-42 1-43 purposes of this section if the amount is less than or equal to the 1-44 amount of the documentary fee presumed reasonable as established by 1-45

rule of the finance commission. SECTION 2. Sections 348.006(e) and (f), Finance Code, as 1-46 amended by this Act, apply only to the sale of a motor vehicle that occurs on or after the effective date of this Act. The sale of a 1-47 1-48 1-49 motor vehicle that occurs before the effective date of this Act is 1-50 governed by the law in effect on the date of the sale, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 1-51 1-52

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
