A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

relating to reciprocity requirements for nonresident insurance agents to offer or sell insurance policies issued by the Texas Windstorm Insurance Association.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 2210.152(a), Insurance Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) The plan of operation must:

- (1) provide for the efficient, economical, fair, and nondiscriminatory administration of the association; and
  - (2) include:
- (A) a plan for the equitable assessment of the members of the association to defray losses and expenses;
  - (B) underwriting standards;
- (C) procedures for accepting and ceding
