AN ACT

2 relating to the restrictions on political activities for a county 3 elections administrator.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 31.035, Election Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as 7 follows:

8 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (d), a [A] county 9 elections administrator may not be a candidate for a public office 10 or an office of a political party, hold a public office, or hold an 11 office of or position in a political party. At the time an 12 administrator becomes a candidate or accepts an office or position 13 in violation of this subsection, the administrator vacates the 14 position of administrator.

15 (d) For a county with a population of less than 1,000, the 16 county elections administrator may hold or be a candidate for a 17 public office if:

18 (1) no part of the jurisdiction of the office is 19 located in the county where the person serves as the elections 20 administrator; and

21 (2) any election for that office is a nonpartisan
22 <u>election.</u>

23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
