1-21 relating to requirements for screenings in public or private
 1-22 schools to detect vision disorders of students.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 36.004, Health and Safety Code, is
 1-25 amended by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:

1-26 (b-1) The rules must allow an individual who attends a
 1-27 public or private school to be screened using photoscreening to
 1-28 detect vision disorders.

1-29 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
 1-30 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
 1-31 Services Commission shall adopt the rules necessary to implement
 1-32 the changes in law made by this Act.

1-33 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
