BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 36.004, Health and Safety Code, amended by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows: 1-24 is 1-25

(b-1) The rules must allow an individual who attends a public or private school to be screened using photoscreening to detect vision disorders. 1-26 1-27 1-28

SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date 1-29 1-30 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human 1-31 Services Commission shall adopt the rules necessary to implement 1-32 the changes in law made by this Act. 1-33

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
