 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the program for improvement of collection of court  
 1-20 costs, fees, and fines imposed in criminal cases.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Article 103.0033(b), Code of Criminal Procedure,  
 1-23 is amended to read as follows:

1-24 (b) This article applies only to [+  
 1-25 [~~(1)~~] a county or [~~with a population of 50,000 or~~  
 1-26 ~~greater; and~~  
 1-27 [~~(2) a~~] municipality with a population of 100,000 or  
 1-28 greater.

1-29 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
 1-30 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
 1-31 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
 1-32 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
 1-33 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
