BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 1951.104, Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows: 1-24

Sec. 1951.104. DUTIES OF COMMITTEE. (a) The committee shall:

1-26 gather and provide information relating to the (1) practice of structural pest control at the request of department or the commissioner; and 1-27 the 1-28 1-29 (2)

advise the department and the commissioner on: (A) the education and curricula requirements for

1-30 1-31 applicants;

(B) the content of examinations under this

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(C) proposed rules and standards on technical 1-35 issues related to structural pest control and rules related to 1-36 enforcement;

1-37 (D) standards and criteria for the issuance of 1-38 licenses under this chapter;

1-39 (E) fees for license applications and 1-40 examinations under this chapter; and

(F) 1-41 other affecting the practice issues of 1-42 structural pest control.

1-43 (b) Before the department proposes a rule for adoption, the department must submit the proposed rule to the committee to 1-44 1-45 provide advice as described by Subsection (a)(2)(C). The committee 1-46 shall:
