BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

Sec. 2054.1183. 1-24 ANNUAL REPORT ON MAJOR INFORMATION RESOURCES PROJECTS. (a) Not later than December 1 of each year, 1-25 the quality assurance team shall report on the status of major 1-26 1-27 1-28 information resources projects to the:

(1)governor;

(2) lieutenant governor;

(3)speaker of the house of representatives;
