1-22 relating to the eligibility of certain NASCAR events to receive
 1-23 funding through the Major Events Reimbursement Program.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Section 5A(a)(4), Chapter 1507 (S.B. 456), Acts
 1-26 of the 76th Legislature, Regular Session, 1999 (Article 5190.14,
 1-27 Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows:

1-28 (4) "Event" means a Super Bowl, a National Collegiate
 1-29 Athletic Association Final Four tournament game, the National
 1-30 Basketball Association All-Star Game, the X Games, the National
 1-31 Hockey League All-Star Game, the Major League Baseball All-Star
 1-32 Game, a game of the National Collegiate Athletic Association Bowl
 1-33 Championship Series or its successor or a National Collegiate
 1-34 Athletic Association Division I Football Bowl Subdivision
 1-35 postseason playoff or championship game, the National Collegiate
 1-36 Athletic Association men's or women's lacrosse championships, a
 1-37 World Cup Soccer game, the World Cup soccer tournament, the Major
 1-38 League Soccer All-Star Game, the Major League Soccer Cup, the
 1-39 Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association National Finals Rodeo, an
 1-40 Elite Rodeo Association World Championship, the United States Open
 1-41 Championship, the World Games, a national collegiate championship
 1-42 of an amateur sport sanctioned by the national governing body of the
 1-43 sport that is recognized by the United States Olympic Committee, an
 1-44 Olympic activity, including a Junior or Senior activity, training
 1-45 program, or feeder program sanctioned by the United States Olympic
 1-46 Committee's Community Olympic Development Program, the Amateur
 1-47 Athletic Union Junior Olympic Games, a mixed martial arts
 1-48 championship, the Breeders' Cup World Championships, a Formula One
 1-49 automobile race, the Moto Grand Prix of the United States, the
 1-50 National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing (NASCAR) All-Star
 1-51 Race, the season-ending Championship Race for the National
 1-52 Association for Stock Car Auto Racing (NASCAR), the Academy of
 1-53 Country Music Awards, the National Cutting Horse Association Triple
 1-54 Crown, a national political convention of the Republican National
 1-55 Committee or the Democratic National Committee, a presidential
 1-56 general election debate, or the largest event held each year at a
 1-57 sports entertainment venue in this state with a permanent seating
 1-58 capacity, including grandstand and premium seating, of not less
 1-59 than 125,000. The term includes any activities related to or
 1-60 associated with an event.

1-61 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only

2-1 to a request submitted by a local organizing committee, endorsing
2-2 municipality, or endorsing county under Section 5A, Chapter 1507
2-3 (S.B. 456), Acts of the 76th Legislature, Regular Session, 1999
2-4 (Article 5190.14, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), on or after the
2-5 effective date of this Act. A request submitted under Section 5A
2-6 before that date is governed by the law in effect on the date the
2-7 request is submitted, and that law is continued in effect for that
2-8 purpose.

2-9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
2-10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
2-11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2-12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
2-13 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
