1-21 relating to parental notification regarding public school teacher
 1-22 qualifications.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 21.057(e), Education Code, is amended to
 1-25 read as follows:

1-26 (e) This section does not apply if a school is required in
 1-27 accordance with Section 1006 [~~1111(h)(6)(B)(ii)]~~, Every Student
 1-28 Succeeds Act (20 U.S.C. Section 6312(e)(1)(B)(ii)) [~~No Child Left~~
 1-29 ~~Behind Act of 2001 (20 U.S.C. Section 6311), and its subsequent~~
 1-30 ~~amendments]~~, to provide notice to a parent or guardian regarding a
 1-31 teacher who does not meet certification requirements at the grade
 1-32 level and subject area in which the teacher is assigned [~~is not~~
 1-33 ~~highly qualified]~~, provided the school provides notice as required
 1-34 by that Act.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-36 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-37 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-38 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-39 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
