1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the issuance of specialty license plates for persons  
1-18 who served in the 11th Armored Cavalry Regiment.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 504.202(e-1), Transportation Code, as  
1-21 amended by Chapters 708 (H.B. 1128) and 716 (H.B. 1273), Acts of the  
1-22 84th Legislature, Regular Session, 2015, is reenacted and amended  
1-23 to read as follows:

1-24 (e-1) Other than license plates issued under Subsection  
1-25 (h), license plates issued under this section may include, on  
1-26 request:

1-27 (1) the emblem of the veteran's branch of service; or  
1-28 (2) one emblem from another license plate to which the  
1-29 person is entitled under Section 504.308, 504.311, 504.312,  
1-30 504.313, 504.3135, 504.314, 504.315, 504.316, 504.318, 504.319,  
1-31 [~~or~~] 504.320, or 504.323.

1-32 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 504, Transportation Code,  
1-33 is amended by adding Section 504.323 to read as follows:

1-34 Sec. 504.323. 11TH ARMORED CAVALRY REGIMENT. The  
1-35 department shall issue specialty license plates for persons who  
1-36 have served in the 11th Armored Cavalry Regiment of the United  
1-37 States Army. The license plates must include the 11th Armored  
1-38 Cavalry Regiment emblem and must include the words "11th Armored  
1-39 Cavalry Regiment" at the bottom of each plate.

1-40 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
