- 7 (c-1) Notwithstanding Section 1951.051(c) or this section,
  8 a school district employee is not required to hold a license under
  9 this chapter or Chapter 76, Agriculture Code, to apply at a school
  10 building or other school district facility, in a manner consistent
  11 with the label, a pesticide that is available for purchase by
- 12 <u>unlicensed members of the public.</u>

  13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

  14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

  15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

  16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

  17 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
