1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to vacancies on the governing body of a Type A general-law
 1-18 municipality.

1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Section 22.008, Local Government Code, is
 1-21 amended to read as follows:

1-22 Sec. 22.008. DISQUALIFICATION FROM OFFICE [~~IF MUNICIPAL~~
 1-23 ~~FUNDS OWED~~]. (a) An officer who is entrusted with the collection or
 1-24 custody of funds belonging to the municipality and who is in default
 1-25 to the municipality may not hold any municipal office until the
 1-26 amount of the default, plus 10 percent interest, is paid to the
 1-27 municipality.

1-28 (b) If a member of the governing body changes the member's
 1-29 place of residence to a location outside the corporate boundaries
 1-30 of the municipality, the member is automatically disqualified from
 1-31 holding the member's office and the office is considered vacant.

1-32 SECTION 2. Section 22.010, Local Government Code, is
 1-33 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d-1) to
 1-34 read as follows:

1-35 (a) If for any reason a single vacancy exists on the
 1-36 governing body of the municipality, a majority of the remaining
 1-37 members who are present and voting, excluding the mayor, may fill
 1-38 the vacancy by appointment unless an election to fill the vacancy is
 1-39 required by Section 11, Article XI, [~~Section 11, of the~~] Texas
 1-40 Constitution. The mayor may vote on the appointment only if there
 1-41 is a tie.

1-42 (d-1) A member of the governing body is ineligible to vote
 1-43 to fill a vacancy on the governing body by special election after
 1-44 resigning from the governing body.

1-45 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
