A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the authority of the Texas Water Development Board to
- 3 use the state participation account of the water development fund
- 4 to provide financial assistance for the development of certain
- 5 facilities.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 16, Water Code, is amended
- 8 by adding Section 16.145 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 16.145. SEAWATER DESALINATION OR AQUIFER STORAGE AND
- 10 RECOVERY FACILITY. (a) In addition to using the account for the
- 11 purposes described by Section 16.131, the board may use the state
- 12 participation account of the development fund to provide financial
- 13 assistance for the development of a seawater desalination or
- 14 aquifer storage and recovery facility, including associated intake
- 15 or distribution facilities, to meet existing or projected future
- 16 water needs.
- (b) Section 16.135 does not apply to the use of the state
- 18 participation account to acquire a facility or an interest in a
- 19 <u>facility described by Subsection (a).</u>
- 20 <u>(c) Before the board may acquire a facility or an interest</u>
- 21 in a facility described by Subsection (a), the board must find
- 22 affirmatively that:
- 23 (1) it is reasonable to expect that the state will
- 24 recover its investment in the facility; and

- 1 (2) the public interest will be served by the
- 2 acquisition of the facility.
- 3 (d) The board may not provide financial assistance under
- 4 this section for a facility unless the facility is included in the
- 5 state water plan.
- 6 (e) The board shall establish a point system for
- 7 prioritizing facilities for which financial assistance is sought
- 8 from the board under this section. The system must include a
- 9 standard for the board to apply in determining whether a facility
- 10 qualifies for financial assistance at the time the application for
- 11 financial assistance is filed with the board.
- 12 (f) The board may not issue more than \$200 million in water
- 13 financial assistance bonds designated by the board as issued to
- 14 provide financial assistance for facilities under this section.
- 15 (g) If the board does not provide financial assistance for a
- 16 facility under this section before September 1, 2022, the board may
- 17 not provide financial assistance for any facility under this
- 18 section after that date.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 16.182, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 20 follows:
- 21 Sec. 16.182. PERMIT REQUIRED. (a) Before the board grants
- 22 the application to buy, receive, or lease the facilities, the
- 23 applicant shall first secure a permit for water use from the
- 24 commission. If the facilities are to be leased, the permit may be
- 25 for a term of years.
- 26 (b) The board may assist the applicant with securing a
- 27 permit for a facility described by Section 16.145.

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- 1 SECTION 3. Sections 17.957(b) and (c), Water Code, are
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 (b) The state participation account is composed of:
- 4 (1) money and assets attributable to water financial
- 5 assistance bonds designated by the board as issued for projects
- 6 described in <u>Sections</u> [Section] 16.131 and 16.145;
- 7 (2) money from the sale, transfer, or lease of a
- 8 project described in Subdivision (1) that was acquired,
- 9 constructed, reconstructed, developed, or enlarged with money from
- 10 the state participation account;
- 11 (3) payments received under a bond enhancement
- 12 agreement with respect to water financial assistance bonds
- 13 designated by the board as issued for projects described in
- 14 Sections [Section] 16.131 and 16.145;
- 15 (4) investment income earned on money on deposit in
- 16 the state participation account;
- 17 (5) money disbursed to the fund from the state water
- 18 implementation fund for Texas as authorized by Section 15.434; and
- 19 (6) any other funds, regardless of their source, that
- 20 the board directs be deposited to the credit of the state
- 21 participation account.
- (c) Money on deposit in the state participation account may
- 23 be used by the board for projects described in <u>Sections</u> [Section]
- 24 16.131 and 16.145 in the manner that the board determines necessary
- 25 for the administration of the fund.
- 26 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
