Sections 75.401(a), (c), (d), (e) and (f), 11 12 Government Code, are amended to read as follows: 13 Sec. 75.401. COURT ADMINISTRATOR SYSTEM FOR DISTRICT AND STATUTORY COUNTY COURTS IN CERTAIN COUNTIES. (a) In a county that 14 has more than one district court or statutory county court, those 15 16 courts may establish and maintain, if approved by [on approval of] the commissioners court, a court administrator system. 17 18 (c) The court administrator is appointed by the judges of the district courts or the statutory county courts served by the 19 20 court administrator if the position of court administrator is budgeted for by commissioners court. The court administrator 21 serves at the pleasure of those judges. 22 23 (d) A court administrator is entitled to reasonable

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compensation, as determined by the judges served and in the salary

3 (e) The judges of the courts served by the court 4 administrator, <u>if included in the county budget by</u> [with the 5 approval of] the commissioners court, shall appoint appropriate 6 staff and support personnel according to the needs of the local 7 jurisdiction.

8 (f) [On order and directive of the judges, the] If included 9 <u>in the county budget, the</u> commissioners court shall fund the court 10 administrator system from fines collected by the courts served by 11 the court administrator. If the fines collected are insufficient to 12 provide the total funding for the program, the county shall provide 13 the additional funds needed.

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
