 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the issuance of permits for the movement of oversize and  
 1-20 overweight vehicles in certain counties; authorizing an increase in  
 1-21 the amount of a fee.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 623.210, Transportation Code, is amended  
 1-24 to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 623.210. OPTIONAL PROCEDURE. This subchapter  
 1-26 provides an optional procedure for the issuance of a permit for the  
 1-27 movement of oversize or overweight vehicles carrying cargo on state  
 1-28 highways located in counties:

1-29 (1) contiguous to the Gulf of Mexico or a bay or inlet  
 1-30 opening into the gulf and:

1-31 (A) ~~[(1)]~~ adjacent to at least two counties with  
 1-32 a population of 550,000 or more; or

1-33 (B) ~~[(2)]~~ bordering the United Mexican States;  
 1-34 or

1-35 (2) contiguous to the Gulf of Mexico or a bay or inlet  
 1-36 opening into the gulf with a population of not more than 200,000 and  
 1-37 adjacent to a county described by Subdivision (1)(A).

1-38 SECTION 2. Section 623.212, Transportation Code, is amended  
 1-39 to read as follows:

1-40 Sec. 623.212. PERMITS BY PORT AUTHORITY. The commission  
 1-41 may authorize a port authority to issue permits for the movement of  
 1-42 oversize or overweight vehicles carrying cargo on state highways  
 1-43 located in counties:

1-44 (1) contiguous to the Gulf of Mexico or a bay or inlet  
 1-45 opening into the gulf and:

1-46 (A) ~~[(1)]~~ adjacent to at least two counties with  
 1-47 a population of 550,000 or more; or

1-48 (B) ~~[(2)]~~ bordering the United Mexican States;  
 1-49 or

1-50 (2) contiguous to the Gulf of Mexico or a bay or inlet  
 1-51 opening into the gulf with a population of not more than 200,000 and  
 1-52 adjacent to a county described by Subdivision (1)(A).

1-53 SECTION 3. Section 623.214(a), Transportation Code, is  
 1-54 amended to read as follows:

1-55 (a) A port authority may collect a fee for permits issued  
 1-56 under this subchapter. Such fees shall not exceed \$120 ~~[\$80]~~ per  
 1-57 trip.

1-58 SECTION 4. Section 623.219(b), Transportation Code, is  
 1-59 amended to read as follows:

1-60 (b) For a permit issued by a port authority located in a  
 1-61 county that is adjacent to at least two counties with a population

2-1 of 550,000 or more, the commission shall, with the consent of the  
 2-2 port authority, designate the most direct route from:  
 2-3 (1) the intersection of Farm-to-Market Road 523 and  
 2-4 Moller Road to the entrance of Port Freeport using Farm-to-Market  
 2-5 Roads 523 and 1495;  
 2-6 (2) the intersection of State Highway 288 and Chlorine  
 2-7 Road to the entrance of Port Freeport using State Highway 288;  
 2-8 (3) the intersection of State Highway 288 and Chlorine  
 2-9 Road to the entrance of Port Freeport using State Highways 288 and  
 2-10 332 and Farm-to-Market Roads 523 and 1495;  
 2-11 (4) the intersection of North Velasco Boulevard and  
 2-12 South Avenue J in the city of Freeport to the entrance of Port  
 2-13 Freeport using North Velasco Boulevard and Farm-to-Market Road  
 2-14 1495; [~~and~~]  
 2-15 (5) 21441 Loop 419 in the city of Sweeny to the  
 2-16 entrance of Port Freeport using Loop 419, State Highways 35 and 36,  
 2-17 and Farm-to-Market Road 1495; and  
 2-18 (6) 5261 Seventh Street in Bay City to the entrance of  
 2-19 Port Freeport using State Highway 35, Loop 419, State Highway 36,  
 2-20 and Farm-to-Market Road 1495.

2-21 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
