1-17 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

1-18 proposing a constitutional amendment on professional sports team  
 1-19 charitable foundations conducting charitable raffles.

1-20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Section 47(d-1), Article III, Texas  
 1-22 Constitution, is amended to read as follows:

1-23 (d-1) The legislature by general law may permit a  
 1-24 professional sports team charitable foundation to conduct  
 1-25 charitable raffles under the terms and conditions imposed by  
 1-26 general law. The law may authorize the charitable foundation to pay  
 1-27 with the raffle proceeds reasonable advertising, promotional, and  
 1-28 administrative expenses. A law enacted under this subsection  
 1-29 applies [may apply] only to an entity [that is] defined as a  
 1-30 professional sports team charitable foundation under that law [on  
 1-31 January 1, 2016,] and may only allow charitable raffles to be  
 1-32 conducted at games hosted at the home venue of the professional  
 1-33 sports team associated with a professional sports team charitable  
 1-34 foundation. In this subsection, "professional sports team" means:

1-35 (1) a team organized in this state that is a member of  
 1-36 Major League Baseball, the National Basketball Association, the  
 1-37 National Hockey League, the National Football League, Major League  
 1-38 Soccer, the American Hockey League, the East Coast Hockey League,  
 1-39 the American Association of Independent Professional Baseball, the  
 1-40 Atlantic League of Professional Baseball, Minor League Baseball,  
 1-41 the National Basketball Association Development League, the  
 1-42 National Women's Soccer League, the Major Arena Soccer League, the  
 1-43 United Soccer League, or the Women's National Basketball  
 1-44 Association;

1-45 (2) a person hosting a motorsports racing team event  
 1-46 sanctioned by the National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing  
 1-47 (NASCAR), INDYCar, or another nationally recognized motorsports  
 1-48 racing association at a venue in this state with a permanent seating  
 1-49 capacity of not less than 75,000;

1-50 (3) an organization hosting a Professional Golf  
 1-51 Association event; or

1-52 (4) any other professional sports team defined by law.

1-53 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be  
 1-54 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2017.  
 1-55 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the  
 1-56 proposition: "The constitutional amendment on professional sports  
 1-57 team charitable foundations conducting charitable raffles."
