1-19 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to prohibiting the temporary closure of segments of the
 1-22 state highway system on days that certain scheduled events are
 1-23 being held in certain municipalities.

1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-25 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 223, Transportation Code,
 1-26 is amended by adding Section 223.051 to read as follows:

1-27 Sec. 223.051. NOTIFICATION BY CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES OF
 1-28 SCHEDULED EVENT. (a) This section applies only to a municipality
 1-29 that:

1-30 (1) is partially located in three counties, two of
 1-31 which have a population of 1.8 million or more;

1-32 (2) is primarily located in a county with a population
 1-33 of 1.8 million or more; and

1-34 (3) has within its boundaries all or part of an
 1-35 international airport operated jointly by two municipalities.

1-36 (b) A contract for an improvement to a segment of the state
 1-37 highway system must prohibit a contractor from temporarily closing
 1-38 the highway, including temporarily relocating or changing an
 1-39 entrance or exit ramp to or from the highway, on the date that an
 1-40 event is scheduled to be held in a municipality in which the
 1-41 improvement is being proposed if, not later than 180 days before the
 1-42 date the event is scheduled to be held, the municipality notifies
 1-43 the department and the contractor of the date.

1-44 SECTION 2. Section 223.051, Transportation Code, as added
 1-45 by this Act, applies only to a contract entered into on or after the
 1-46 effective date of this Act. A contract entered into before the
 1-47 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
 1-48 date the contract was entered into, and the former law is continued
 1-49 in effect for that purpose.

1-50 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
