1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 707.017, Transportation Code, is amended  
 1-24 to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 707.017. REGISTRATION AFTER CIVIL PENALTY IMPOSED  
 1-26 [ENFORCEMENT]. ~~The [(a) If the owner of a motor vehicle is~~  
 1-27 ~~delinquent in the payment of a civil penalty imposed under this~~  
 1-28 ~~chapter, the]~~ county assessor-collector or the Texas Department of  
 1-29 Motor Vehicles may not refuse to register a motor vehicle alleged to  
 1-30 have been involved in a [the] violation of this chapter solely  
 1-31 because the owner of the motor vehicle is delinquent in the payment  
 1-32 of a civil penalty imposed under this chapter.
