BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 411, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 411.0094 to read as follows:

Sec. 411.0094. AUTOMATIC LICENSE PLATE READER. (a) In this section, "automatic license plate reader" means a system that reads and records license plate numbers taken from digital photographs.

(b) A law enforcement agency may use an automatic license

plate reader.

- (c) Images and any related data produced from an automatic license plate reader under Subsection (b) may be used only for the following law enforcement purposes:
