- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 21.402, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (g) and adding Subsections (c-2), (c-3), and
- 7 (d) to read as follows:

- 8 (c-2) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), for the 2017-2018
- 9 school year, a classroom teacher is entitled to a monthly salary
- 10 that is at least equal to the sum of:
- 11 (1) the monthly salary the teacher would have received
- 12 for the 2017-2018 school year under the district's salary schedule
- 13 for the 2016-2017 school year, if that schedule had been in effect
- 14 for the 2017-2018 school year, including any local supplement and
- 15 any money representing a career ladder supplement the teacher would
- 16 have received in the 2017-2018 school year; and
- 17 (2) \$400.
- 18 <u>(c-3)</u> Subsection (c-2) and this subsection expire September
- 19 <u>1, 2018.</u>
- 20 (d) A classroom teacher employed by a school district in the
- 21 2017-2018 school year is, as long as the teacher is employed by the
- 22 same district, entitled to a salary that is at least equal to the
- 23 salary the teacher received for the 2017-2018 school year.
- 24 (g) The commissioner may adopt rules to govern the

- 1 application of this section, including rules that:
- 2 (1) require the payment of a minimum salary under this
- 3 section to a person employed in more than one capacity for which a
- 4 minimum salary is provided and whose combined employment in those
- 5 capacities constitutes full-time employment; and
- 6 (2) specify the credentials a person must hold to be
- 7 considered a [speech pathologist or] school nurse under this
- 8 section.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 42.2513(a), Education Code, is amended
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 (a) A school district, including a school district that is
- 12 otherwise ineligible for state aid under this chapter, is entitled
- 13 to state aid in an amount equal to the sum of:
- 14 (1) the product of \$500 multiplied by the number of
- 15 full-time district employees, other than administrators or
- 16 employees subject to the minimum salary schedule under Section
- 17 21.402; [and]
- 18 (2) the product of \$4,000 multiplied by the number of
- 19 classroom teachers employed by the district; and
- 20 (3) the product of \$250 multiplied by the number of
- 21 part-time district employees, other than administrators.
- 22 SECTION 3. Section 21.402(c-1), Education Code, is
- 23 repealed.
- SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
- 25 school year.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
