1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to certain substances listed in Penalty Group 2 of the
1-20 Texas Controlled Substances Act.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 481.103(d), Health and Safety Code, is
1-23 repealed.

1-24 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
1-25 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
1-26 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
1-27 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
1-28 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
1-29 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
1-30 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
1-31 before that date.

1-32 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
