A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-17 relating to the abolishment of the Office of Immigration and 1-18 Refugee Affairs and the Governor's Advisory Committee on 1-19 Immigration and Refugees.

1-20 1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 752, Government Code, is repealed. SECTION 2. The Office of Immigration and Refugee A

1-22 SECTION 2. The Office of Immigration and Refugee Affairs 1-23 and the Governor's Advisory Committee on Immigration and Refugees 1-24 are abolished. On the effective date of this Act:

1-25 (1) all money other than federal money of the office is 1-26 transferred to the Health and Human Services Commission;

1-27 (2) all contracts, leases, rights, obligations, and 1-28 personal property, including records, in the custody of the office, 1-29 other than federal contracts, leases, rights, obligations, and 1-30 personal property, are transferred to the commission; and

1-31 (3) all remaining federal money, contracts, leases, 1-32 rights, obligations, and personal property are transferred as 1-33 directed by the director of the Office of Refugee Resettlement of 1-34 the United States Department of Health and Human Services.

1-35 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-36 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-37 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-38 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-39 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
