 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the authority of a court to return certain fees to a
 1-20 person who is the subject of an order of nondisclosure of criminal
 1-21 history record information.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Subchapter E-1, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
 1-24 amended by adding Section 411.0746 to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 411.0746. RETURN OF FEES. A court that issues an order
 1-26 of nondisclosure of criminal history record information under this
 1-27 subchapter may order that any fee, or portion of a fee, required to
 1-28 be paid under this subchapter or other law in relation to the order
 1-29 be returned to the person who is the subject of that order.

1-30 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
 1-31 an order of nondisclosure of criminal history record information
 1-32 issued on or after the effective date of this Act. The issuance of
 1-33 an order of nondisclosure of criminal history record information
 1-34 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
 1-35 effect on the date the order was issued, and the former law is
 1-36 continued in effect for that purpose.

1-37 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
