1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the temporary approval of a private or independent
1-20 college or university to continue to participate in the tuition
1-21 equalization grant program.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Section 61.222(c), Education Code, is amended to
1-24 read as follows:

1-25 (c) The coordinating board may grant temporary approval for
1-26 a period of two years and may renew the approval twice [~~once~~].

1-27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-28 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-29 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-30 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-31 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
