 1-17 AN ACT

1-18 relating to a requirement for ballot propositions.  
 1-19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
 1-20 SECTION 1. Section 52.072, Election Code, is amended by  
 1-21 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:  
 1-22 (f) A proposition must substantially submit the question  
 1-23 with such definiteness and certainty in identifying the  
 1-24 proposition's chief features that the voters are not misled.  
 1-25 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only  
 1-26 to an election ordered on or after the effective date of this Act.  
 1-27 An election ordered before the effective date of this Act is  
 1-28 governed by the law in effect when the election was ordered.  
 1-29 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
