1-17 relating to the statewide preceptorship program in family medicine.
1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
1-19 SECTION 1. Section 58.006(a), Education Code, is amended to
1-20 read as follows:
1-21 (a) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board may
1-22 contract with one or more organizations to operate the statewide
1-23 preceptorship program in general internal medicine, the statewide
1-24 preceptorship program in family medicine, and the statewide
1-25 preceptorship program in general pediatrics for medical students
1-26 enrolled in Texas medical schools.
1-27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-28 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-29 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-30 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-31 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
