1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the ability of certain students to enroll full-time in
1-20 courses provided through the state virtual school network.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 30A.002(b), Education Code, is amended
1-23 to read as follows:

1-24 (b) A student is eligible to enroll full-time in courses
1-25 provided through the state virtual school network only if the
1-26 student:

1-27 (1) was enrolled in a public school in this state in
1-28 the preceding school year; or

1-29 (2) ~~[has been placed in substitute care in this~~
1-30 ~~state,~~ regardless of whether the student was enrolled in a public
1-31 school in this state in the preceding school year;

1-32 (A) has been placed in substitute care in this
1-33 state; or

1-34 (B) is a dependent of a member of the United
1-35 States military who has been deployed or transferred to, or
1-36 otherwise currently resides in, this state.

1-37 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
1-38 school year.

1-39 SECTION 3. The Texas Education Agency is required to
1-40 implement this Act only if the legislature appropriates money
1-41 specifically for that purpose. If the legislature does not
1-42 appropriate money specifically for that purpose, the agency may,
1-43 but is not required to, implement this Act using other
1-44 appropriations available for the purpose.

1-45 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-46 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-47 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-48 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-49 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
