

2-1 (14) a county that borders the United Mexican States
2-2 and in which there is located a national park of more than 400,000
2-3 acres;

2-4 (15) a county that has a population of 28,000 or less,
2-5 that has no more than four municipalities, and that is located
2-6 wholly in the Edwards Aquifer Authority established by Chapter 626,
2-7 Acts of the 73rd Legislature, Regular Session, 1993;

2-8 (16) a county that has a population of 25,000 or less,
2-9 whose territory is less than 750 square miles, and that has two
2-10 incorporated municipalities, each with a population of 800 or less,
2-11 at least one of which is located on the Frio River;

2-12 (17) a county that has a population of 34,000 or more
2-13 and borders Lake Buchanan;

2-14 (18) a county that has a population of more than 45,000
2-15 and less than 75,000, that borders the United Mexican States, and
2-16 that borders or contains a portion of Falcon Lake;

2-17 (19) a county with a population of 22,000 or less that
2-18 borders the Neches River and in which there is located a national
2-19 preserve;

2-20 (20) a county that has a population of 28,000 or less
2-21 and that borders or contains a portion of Lake Livingston;

2-22 (21) a county through which the Pedernales River flows
2-23 and in which the birthplace of a president of the United States is
2-24 located;

2-25 (22) a county that has a population of more than 15,000
2-26 but less than 20,000 and borders Lake Buchanan;

2-27 (23) a county with a population of less than 11,000
2-28 that is bordered by the Sulphur River;

2-29 (24) a county that has a population of 16,000 or more
2-30 and borders the entire north shore of Lake Somerville;

2-31 (25) a county that has a population of 20,000 or less
2-32 and that is bordered by the Brazos and Navasota Rivers;

2-33 (26) a county that has a population of more than 15,000
2-34 and less than 25,000 and is located on the Trinity and Navasota
2-35 Rivers;

2-36 (27) a county that has a population of less than 15,000
2-37 and that is bordered by the Trinity and Navasota Rivers;

2-38 (28) a county that borders or contains a portion of the
2-39 Neches River, the Sabine River, and Sabine Lake; and

2-40 (29) a county that borders Whitney Lake.

2-41 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
2-42 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
2-43 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2-44 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
2-45 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
