BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 85.025(a-1), Family Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-24 (a-1) The court may render a protective order sufficient to 1-25 protect the applicant and members of the applicant's family or 1-26 household that is effective for a period that exceeds two years if the court finds that the person who is the subject of the protective 1-27 1-28 order:
